He Knew Something Was Wrong

Each of us is "making a name" for himself by the way we attend Sunday and mid-week Bible classes and worship services. What kind of name do you have? *"A good name is to be chosen rather than great riches, and loving favor rather than silver and gold"* (Proverbs 22:1).
