TO THE WORK

Anyway you look at it, work is a four letter word. However, it is a powerful one and used often in the Scriptures. In the King James Version of the Bible, the word work appears 69 times in 63 verses and the word works appears 110 times in 108 verses. There is no doubt of the importance of work in the life of a Christian. Even faith is referred to as a work, as we find in John 6:28-29. When Jesus was asked, "What shall we do, that we might work the works of God?" he answered, "This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent". I have often wondered how those who say we are not saved by works, but by faith explain this. As well as Ephesians 2:10, when the inspired writer wrote, "For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them". I heard it put this way, "While we may not be saved by our works, we will be lost by our failure to do them. Of course there are works that will not save, such as the works of the Law, by which no flesh is justified (Galatians 2:16). Then there are the works of the flesh described in Galatians 5:19-21, for those who do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God. The works by which man can boast, which are set against "for by grace are you saved through faith" ((Ephesians 2:9) You will get no argument from me as to the merits of these works as I know of no one who teaches we are saved by either the works of the Law, the works of the flesh or boastful works. Work is used both as a verb and noun. Jesus said in John 9:4 - "I must work the works of him that sent me." James makes it clear, "Faith without works is dead" (James 2:20). The only time the words faith and works are used in the same verse is found in James 2:24. "Ye see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only". It is no wonder Martin Luther wanted to remove the book of James from the Bible. He also added the word only to Romans 5:1, "Therefore being justified by faith (only), we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ". We don't question are we saved by faith, but when are we saved by faith. Faith that saves is faith that obeys. -author unknown
