There Is Safety In the Ship

In Acts chapter 27, Paul by request is being transported to appear before Caesar. They encountered a tempestuous sea, as they were traveling by boat. Paul had previously warned the centurions and ship's crew of the dangers that they would encounter, if they sailed from Fair Havens, near the city of Lasea (Acts 27:8-11). After certain day of dealing with the raging sea, fear began to take its toll on the ship's crew and the soldiers. They began to take measures to hopefully survive the storm by lightening the ship (vs.18). Now when neither sun nor stars appeared for many days, and no small tempest beat on the ship, all hope that those who were in the ship would survive, they gave up (vs. 20). But after long abstinence from food, Paul stood in the midst of them and said "men you should have listened to me, and not have sailed from Crete and incurred this disaster and loss" (vs. 21). And now I urge you to take heart, for there will be no loss of life among you, but only in the ship (vs. 22). Paul informed them "for there stood by me this night an angel of God to whom I belong and serve" (vs. 23). The angel saying to Paul, "do not be afraid, Paul; you must be brought before Caesar; and indeed God has granted you all those who sail with you (vs. 24). "Therefore take heart, men, for I believe God that it will be just as it was told me" (vs. 25). However, we must run aground on a certain island (vs. 26). Vs. 31 - Paul said to the centurion and the soldiers, unless these men stay in the ship, you cannot be saved. Christ calls for us to stay in the ship because our eternal safety and security is at stake (Matt. 11:28-30, Phil. 2:5, and I John 5:3). In I Cor. 15:58 it states, "Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, unmovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord. Stay in the ship, because there is safety there (I Peter 2: 21-22).
