How Am I Doing?

We often see signs placed on the back of trucks that say, "How is my driving?" These signs are placed on trucks to provide an avenue for other drivers to report unsafe drivers, or to pass a compliment for courteous driving. Parents ask school teachers, "How is my child doing in the classroom?" Caring parents are concerned about their children's conduct in the classroom. Are they listening to the teacher, reading their books, or are they misbehaving? How are we as church members doing in the worship service and Bible classes?

The apostle Paul tells the young man Timothy "Be thou an example of believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity" (I Timothy 4:12). Paul told Titus, "in all things showing thyself a pattern of good works..." Paul told the Corinthian brethren when they were assembled, "let all things be done unto edifying." (I Corinthians 14:26). Although these scriptures may not deal directly with the subject of this writing, they do lend references to our need for asking the question, "How am I doing?" in the worship services and Bible classes.

Many church buildings have a sign above the door of the auditorium that reads "Keep Silence Before Him." The purpose for such signs is to remind us that are entering that we are there for the purpose of worshipping God. This is especially true on the Lords's Day. What does keep silence before Him mean? I certainly don't mean that we should never speak while in the building; however, when we are engaged in the worship service there is a need for reverence and respect for God, and He is the Object of our worship.

In considering our worship, we should strive to do all we can to make it a service that is acceptable to God our Heavenly Father. We should be considerate of everyone present, doing our best not to distract their attention from the worship service. Some things to consider in meeting this challenge are talking, passing notes, cell phone activity, eating, drinking and moving around (unless necessary). We should always be asking ourselves "HOW AM I DOING?"
