A Sower Went Out To Sow ...

In Luke 8, Jesus told a parable of a sower who went out to sow. Some of the seed fell on the hard pathway soil, some on thorny ground, some on rocky soil, and some on good ground.

There are several lessons from this parable; lessons on what is represented by the different soils, what is represented by the seed (the word of God), what happens to the seed on the various soils, but also "a sower went out to sow".

The task of this sower was to sow the seed; to spread the word of God. Likewise, we have a responsibility to teach the good news of Jesus, the gospel. Jesus gave the "Great Commission" to His disciple in Mark 16: 15 - 16 and Matthew 28: 18 - 20.
