God Specializes In Brokenness!

Let's be really honest, examining our own lives and realizing that we all experience brokenness in some way or another.

As we look in the book of Ruth, and especially see the life of Naomi; the woman who told those in Bethlehem, don't call me Naomi (pleasant), but call me Mara (bitterness). Naomi experienced the cycle of **delight**, as she married and she and her husband, Elimelech, had two sons. However, she faced **disaster**. There was famine, her husband died, and her two sons died. She was in a foreign land, with two daughter-in-laws, and no husband, and no security from her sons. Naomi went into **depression**. She seemed to have lost everything. She even blamed God. One daughter-in-law went back to her home land, however Ruth was determined to stay with Naomi. Naomi was not able to see the total picture, not able to see at that point in time how God specializes in brokenness! However, there was **deliverance**!. Ruth meets Boaz. Ruth is encouraged by Naomi. Romance developed between Boaz and Ruth. They married, and had a son, Obed. Obed was the grandfather of King David.

Notice Matthew 1: 1, "The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the Son of David, ..." Boaz, Ruth, Obed, Jesse, David ... all in the genealogy of Jesus Christ.

There are times in our brokenness that we don't see how, or when God is going to bring deliverance to our pain, suffering, and problems. However, God specializes in brokenness. Romans 8: 28, "And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose."
