There are several different things that you could get involved with and I encourage you to do that. My heart is so full right now due to watching all my family at the first responder's luncheon a few months ago and from seeing the ones that have been at the hospitals waiting with family members. All of this shows a love for Christ and it brings God's glory out in this area around us. Jesus said "GO" in the great commission, and you have said, "Here I am, send me" and we are sowing for the Kingdom.

Just as my heart is full and excited for what is to come, I want us to step back for a minute and remember some things to safe guard our lives to ensure we always strive to bring glory to God. Paul was proud of Timothy for all the work he was doing for the Kingdom but also stopped and reminded him of some things to watch out for or guard as he was working for the glory of God. In 1 Timothy 4:12-16, Paul tells Timothy that even though he is doing great things, he is still subject to failing himself but also those around him. That is a deep thought to realize, that if I am not living for Christ, I can be a cause for someone else not living for Christ too.

First let's note verse 12. It is a passage we know well, and we speak to our young people, but it also speaks volumes to the rest of us. We need to be examples in everything we do in our lives. We need to show Christ in our word, in our conduct, in our love, in our spirit, in our faith and in our purity.

How do we do that though, but reading on into verse 13, make sure we are giving attention to the Word of God!! Just as we read in the latter part of Romans, let the Word transform you to be more like Christ. Jesus said that where your treasure is, your heart will be there also (Matt. 6:21). What is in your heart? Is it the Word of God? In John 1, it speaks of Jesus being the Word! If you want to know and have a close bond with Jesus, then it will be through His Word! Let it transform you.

In verse 14, Paul told timothy not to neglect the gift that is in him. He was talking more of the power of the Holy Spirit Timothy had been given. But we need to remember, God gives all of us gifts, or talents that we can use for His kingdom. We do not need to neglect those and make sure we are using them to help sow the seed in the Kingdom.

Paul then almost repeats himself by going deeper in giving attention to the Word of God in verse 15. He says to meditate on these things. He is saying we should be thinking on God and His Word all the time in everything we do. We do that by being 100% invested in giving our all for God. When this happens, the world around we will see it. This is all before we even sit down to talk with someone about God. They will see God in our lives and know we are truly in surrender to Him.

He then finishes up in verse 16 with saying, "Timothy be careful! Be watchful for yourself because you are not exempt from falling away. You must continue in the Word the God and by doing that you will save both yourself and those who around you! Let's continue to be ALL in for God and His Word!!! This will be evident in the world around
