## Words To Ponder.....

O Lord, rebuke me not in your anger, nor discipline me in your wrath. Be gracious to me, O Lord, for I am languishing; heal me, O Lord, for my bones are troubled. My soul also is greatly troubled. But you, O Lord—how long? ...The Lord has heard my plea; the Lord accepts my prayer. Psalm 6:1-3,9

None of us like to be disciplined. It means we have fallen short in some area that required correction. Here in this Psalm, David cries out for mercy due the discipline of the Lord. It reminds me of the words in Hebrews 12:5-6:

And have you forgotten the exhortation that addresses you as sons? "My son do not regard lightly the discipline of the Lord, nor be weary when reproved by Him. For the Lord disciplines the one He loves and chastises every son whom He receives."

Notice David's emotions: He was deeply troubled, alarmed, uneasy, exhausted and depressed. His prayer life is struggling too. In short all he could do was weep in the situation he was in. By God's discipline, all David could do is see the reality of his messed-up life. He cried for mercy and God replied letting him know his walk starts with his reality and only then could he move forward. He moved from request to praise and found answered prayer. What I love about this Psalm, is when we do as David did, God goes to work in our lives, allowing for authentic reasons to praise Him, therefore deepening our faith and walk in Him. Do we need to come to terms with our reality in order to walk with God?
