Words To Ponder

“As soon then as they were come to land, they saw a fire of coals there, and fish laid thereon, and bread. Jesus saith unto them, Bring of the fish which ye have now caught” (Jn 21:9-10).

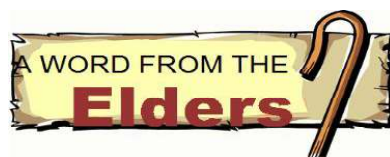
Interestingly, Jesus fed 5,000 plus with two fish and five loaves (Mt 14:17-21) then another 4,000 plus with a few fish and seven loaves (Mt 15:34-38).

In the text, the resurrected Christ had fish and a fire prepared but told the disciples to bring what fish they had.

God needs nothing from us (Acts 17:24) but still wants us to minister to Him. He supplies all of our needs (Phil 4:19), yet wants us to bring what fish we have.

There is a lesson here. While God providentially takes care of us, He still expects us to do our part as active participants in this relationship. It might do well to sometimes offer a prayer without asking God for anything, but simply thank Him for being better to us than we deserve.
