Words To Ponder....

Psalm 7

O LORD, my God, I take refuge in you; save and deliver me from all who pursue me, or they will tear me like a lion and rip me to pieces with no one to rescue me...O righteous God, who searches minds and hearts, bring to an end the violence of the wicked and make the righteous secure...I will give thanks to the LORD because of His righteousness and will sing praise to the name of the LORD Most High Psalm 7:1-2,9,17

When things go opposite than what a person expects, they tend to throw their hands up in despair and ask why me. This is a normal response within the world we live in. This is an area where a Christian is called to be different. Over in Philippians 4:6-7, Paul tells us through inspiration:

"Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus"

Here in this Psalm, David is very frustrated, betrayed, been unjustly accused as result of Saul's jealously, envy and rivalry. Simply put David starts out and says to God, "THIS ISN'T FAIR". How many times have we thrown our hands up like this to our God? In the context, it's understandable why David would feel this way. He is the anointed by God, but running for his life from the king, who was also anointed by God. But even though David had a moment of weakness, as we all do, he comes back and remembers God's righteousness is his security (v. 9). God's righteousness is guarding us as well and we need to always give thanks to the LORD because of it!!
