Psalm 10

Why, O Lord, do you stand far off? Why do you hide yourself in times of trouble? In his pride the wicked does not seek him; in all his thoughts there is no room for God. His victims are crushed, they collapse; they fall under his strength. You hear, O Lord, the desire of the afflicted; you encourage them, and you listen to their cry, defending the fatherless and the oppressed, in order that man, who is of the earth, may terrify no more

—Psalm 10:1,4,10,17-18

When we are faced with something that turns our world upside down. Where do we turn? We turn to God, but there may have been times where we ask why is He? In our minds we believe that in the time of our most desperate need God is far away or hiding from us. This Psalm helps us in our reaction when we are faced with mindset:

- —We need to **LAMENT**. As we see David so many times through his life, he would pour out his soul to God and let the realness of his emotions flood out to the Creator. We need to allow for the same thing.
- —We need to **FACE REALITY**. After we lament, we need to face the reality of the situation. God said He would not leave us or forsake us, so He is always there. We are the ones that move. Yes evil seems to win sometimes and seem to be blessed in their wickedness, but there will be a judgment and every word and deed will be taken before our Lord and Savior.
- —We need to **PRAY**. One of our most powerful spiritual blessings is being able to go to our God in prayer. We can pray for the helpless, to see the trouble and grief, or to break down the evil that is happening. Remember God is much bigger than any problem, so why fear coming to Him to ask!
- —We need to **PRAISE**. David was wonderful at expressing his faith that the Lord hears, listens, encourages, and defends. As we praise our Lord and give everything over to him, our terror and fear will diminish.

In short, we need to be honest with our GOD. He knows our hearts, so why do we try to hide anything from Him. Honesty with ourselves and Him will begin to deepen our praise for Him.
