Rita McDonald - health issues

"For he established a testimony in Jacob, And appointed a law in Israel, Which he commanded our fathers, That they should make them known to their children:" (Ps 78:5).

As we celebrate Father's Day, I would like to notice characteristics that defined some "fathers" in the Psalms.

Some fathers "tempted the Lord" (Ps 95:9). These fathers had seen the miracles of Egypt and the miraculous provision of God in the wilderness; however, they still tempted the Lord. Some fathers "trusted the Lord" (Ps 22:4,5). Those fathers of the faithful remnant trusted God throughout the OT perils. Some fathers "testified of the Lord" (Ps 44:1-3). These fathers testified to their children how God blessed Israel beyond measure.

The fathers in Psalms tempted the Lord, trusted the Lord, and testified of the Lord. As fathers, let us take note of these points in order to fulfill the command given by Paul (Eph 6:4).
