### From the Heart of a Preacher:

I must admit, this article is not completely of my own. I came across one recently that was titled 10 Heartaches of a Preacher. For me in this article, I want to share a few that do hit home with us as preachers as well as for elders too.

- 1. We mourn when marriages fall apart.** In the position we serve, we do usually get both sides of the story and we see both anguish and sin. A lot of us have been around long enough to see the damage that divorce will cause and it is heartbreaking to watch.
- 2. We hurt when young people make decisions that lead down the path of trouble.** This point is hard. I don't want any of our young people to go the path of the world, but neither can we make the decisions for them. So, we pray pray and pray some more in hopes that they will make the right decisions and stay on the path of righteousness.
- 3. We will beat ourselves up when the sermon wasn't as strong as we thought it would be.** We are our own worse critics. We hold this task of bringing God's Word before you as one of the highest of the land behind teaching our own families. Therefore, we strive to do our very best each time we step behind the pulpit.
- 4. We sometimes grieve the sin of others more than they do.** The reality is we can't bring anyone to repentance on our own. Therefore, it can be very difficult to watch brothers and sisters continue in sin that will lead to their destruction.
- 5. We often feel guilty even expressing any of these thoughts.** Sometimes we don't want our spiritual family to know we are struggling with things. We are afraid it shows weakness or lack of faith. But we should know better. We are just men too, striving to live the best life in Christ we can, but still fall short.

We do what we do because we LOVE you and for the glory and love of GOD. As we remember you in our prayers, remember us as well!!!
