Love of God

One of my sister's favorite stories was that of beauty and the beast. Essentially the main message of the story is that the beast (that really was a handsome prince) had to be loved as a beast before the last petal fell off a rose. Only then would he become a handsome prince again. At the end of the story Belle truly loves the beast therefore allowing him to become human again.

This is very true principle with people. If you treat someone poorly or like an animal, then the outcome will be as you would expect. That person will then act poorly and like an animal. But the opposite is also true, you treat someone with love and respect then that will help them become something of love and respect. Here's the point: as people **WE LOVE THE BEAUTIFUL BUT HATE THE THINGS WE SEE AS UGLY!**

However, we forget that we ourselves when we are separated from our GOD, we are ugly. We are sinful creatures that are stained and dirty like the beast of the story.

"For while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly. For one will scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die—but God shows His love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us (Romans 5:6-8)

Before becoming a child of God through obeying the gospel, we were beasts and had the curse of death in our lives. We were stained with ugliness and sin. But remember the greatness of God. His love is not based on who we are, it is based on WHO HE IS!! He first loved us. If we love God, we will love others too.
