

#### In Unsettled Times -Dan Jenkins-

We live in a world of change. James' words, "... *ye know not what shall be on the morrow*," emphasize that almost every hour of every day brings something new to our lives. In view of our rapidly changing world we would be well advised to remember what God has provided for our help.

Our unchanging God can help us remain steadfast. The ship that has its anchor firmly attached can withstand the strongest storm. On every hand we see change, but with our souls anchored to an eternal God the storms cannot sway us. David describes the blessed man as one whose "*heart is fixed, trusting in the Lord*" (Psalm 112:7).
