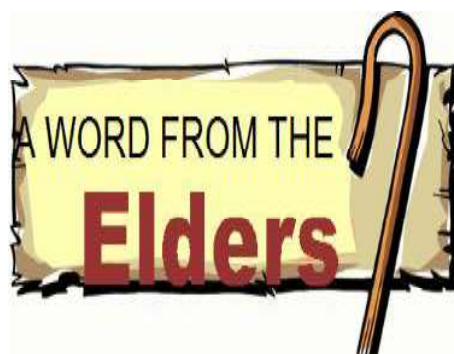
In Unsettled Times

We live in a world of change. James' words, "... *ye know not what shall be on the morrow*," emphasize that almost every hour of every day brings something new to our lives. In view of our rapidly changing world we would be well advised to remember what God has provided for our help.

Our unchanging God can help us remain steadfast. The ship that has its anchor firmly attached can withstand the strongest storm. On every hand we see change, but with our souls anchored to an eternal God the storms cannot sway us. David describes the blessed man as one whose "*heart is fixed, trusting in the Lord*" (Psalm 112:7). The result of trusting in the Lord is that while others lose their moorings, the child of God remains unmoved. The God of our youth is the same God we have in old age. He has not changed and such can give stability in every age.

The unchanging Word can help us (Psalm 119:7-11). The promises of God are eternal and a life built on these promises will be one characterized by steadfastness.
