The loss of a loved one causes a period of mourning for us all. I've attended funerals where the program title stated, “Celebration of life of...” or “Homegoing celebration of...”.

Can we truly celebrate the “loss” a loved one? God our Father sees three classes of people: safe (babies and those incapable of understanding/ obeying the gospel), saved (saints), sinners (lost and unrepentant). God counts the death of the safe and saved as “precious” (something to be valued) because He no longer has to share them with the world. 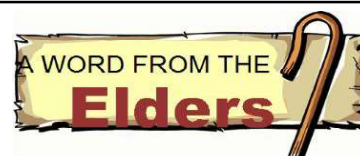
