“Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an example” (Phil 3:17).

There are various types of leadership. Leadership curriculum details the nuances that define leadership styles.

Some lead only from the front based on commands. Some lead from the rear by pushing and prodding. These are not always bad.

I submit to you that we should lead from the middle. Leading from the middle allows us to be in front of some and behind others; however, this leadership is done by example and uses the pronoun “we” instead of “you”.

When our words match our actions, leading by example is extraordinary! Always remember that “actions speak louder” than words but the volume increases exponentially when the words match the actions (Jn 14:15; Lk 6:46).

Let us be the example of God that the world needs by matching our words with our actions (Mt 5:13-16; Phil 2:15; 1 Tim 4:12)
