“Behold, happy is the man whom God correcteth: therefore despise not thou the chastening of the Almighty:” (Job 5:17).

However, when we can pinpoint the cause/reason of our chastening, we count it joy because God loves us enough to attempt to correct us and save us from ourselves (Heb 12:5-13).
