There are many things I do that annoys my wife. But the one thing that makes her mad the quickest is if I keep hitting the snooze button in the morning. A lot of us probably do it thinking that we can "sneak" a few more minutes of sleep in but let's be honest the sleep is that good as much as we think it is and we would have been better off setting the alarm at the right time and got up like a responsible person.

But this example got me thinking, how often do we push the snooze button on God? I am thankful that our God is longsuffering merciful and loving, but how often does He give us the opportunity to get our life right with Him, or put opportunities out in front of us to show others Christ? We would all be ashamed if we knew just how many.

Over in Luke 10:38-42, we see the story of Mary and Martha. Here Jesus came to visit, and the scene unfolds to show Mary listening to Jesus while Martha was busy making sure the house was in order. Recall what Jesus tells Martha after she gets mad at Mary for not helping with the house, "Martha, you are worried and upset about many things, but one thing is necessary. Mary has chosen the good portion, which will not be taken away from her." Mary didn't hit the snooze button on Jesus but chose to put Him first. Another example is the disciples in the garden (Matt. 26:36-43). They should have been praying with Jesus but instead hit the snooze button and took a nap.

Quit hitting the snooze button on your walk with Christ. WAKE up and chose Him first!
