"And as they came out, they found a man of Cyrene, Simon by name: him they compelled to bear his cross" (Mt 27:32).

Have you ever asked someone to do something for you and could tell immediately they did not want to do it though they accepted the task? Their countenance immediately changes as they, with a grimace, say, "Yes."

The grammar of our text indicates that Simon absolutely did not want to bear the cross of Christ. That cross, a punishment reserved for slaves, pirates, and enemies of the state, was the most humiliating and heinous way to die. Who in their right mind would "choose" to bear the cross, especially for One who was an enemy of the Jewish and Roman states?

Often even Christians struggle with bearing the cross; however, if we truly desire to be with Christ at the consummation of all things (Mt 10:38), we MUST bear His cross, which really becomes our cross (Lk 9:23). Christians should NEVER feel "compelled" to bear the cross, because in the cross we share the glories of the sufferings of our Lord (Gal 6:14; Phil 3:10) and manifest a hope that we will be with Him throughout the ceaseless ages of eternity (Rev 2:10)!
